WHY THE UNBS MANDATE OF STANDARDS ENFORCEMENT IS

Under Section 2, Sub Section (1) (f) of the UNBS Act, **UNBS** is mandated to enforce standards in protection of the public against harmful, dangerous and substandard products.

While,

Section 20 of the UNBS Act prohibits the manufacture, sale, distribution or holding for the purpose of selling any product that does not meet compulsory Uganda standards.





Substandard products find their way to the market








SAFETY: Chinese Milk contaminated with melamine affected thousands of children who developed kidney stones


